### **Reception and entrance gates**

Please note that the reception desk and the entrance gates are open daily from 8 am – 12:30 pm and from 2:30 pm – 10 pm. At all other times the gates are locked! Even the Campsite Team needs a little shut-eye!

### **Breakfast roll service**

Would you like fresh German rolls for breakfast tomorrow morning? During the peak season you can order rolls at the reception desk until 9 pm the evening before. The rolls are generally delivered by 8 am and can be picked up at the reception desk. A price list is also available.

### **Accessible bathrooms for persons with disabilities**

Two big and modern accessible bathroom facilities are located on the back of our recently renovated sanitary facilities. The key is available at the reception desk for a refundable deposit of 20 Euros. You will receive the 20 Euros back when you return the key at the end of your visit.

### **Showers**

Use of the showers is free, but we do ask you to be kind to the environment and use water sparingly.

### **Laundry facilities**

The key for the laundry room is available at the reception desk for a refundable deposit of 20 Euros. You will receive the 20 Euros back when you return the key.

### **Dogs at the campsite**

In the interest of all our guests, we ask that you keep your four-legged friends on a leash while at the campsite.

### **Guests in the tent area**

Please do not drive in the tent area with your car or motorbike/motorcycle. It is a disturbance to the other guests and is harmful to the grass. You can of course park along the road/bushes. Please try to park as close as possible to the bushes as to not block the way on our narrow road.

### **Emergency numbers**

In case of a medical emergency, call the national emergency number **112** (for all emergency calls).

The emergency police number is **110**.

### **Electricity and WLAN**

If you need electricity, please inform the reception desk. Electricity is provided at a flat-fee of 3 Euros per night. WLAN is free of charge.

### **Garbage and recycling**

In Germany we are required by law to separate recyclables from other kinds of garbage. If you're not familiar with the system here, we ask that

you take a moment to read the following information.

Most plastics and packaging should be put into the "gelbe Sack" or yellow bag, which is located at the "Wertstoffinsel" in the back of the bath house. If you're not sure if something should go in the "gelbe Sack" look for the "grüne Punkt" symbol, which is a circle with two arrows in it.

Glass containers should be placed in the large container across the street from the entrance to the campsite.

All other garbage should be put in the "Restmüll-container" (left-over trash) located in the back of the bath house.

Tübingen's outdoor swimming pool is located on the other side of the Neckar River. We offer discounted tickets for our guests at the reception desk.

You can obtain a fishing permit at the reception.

### Barbecue

A grill is available for the use of the campers. If you are going to grill, please stop by the reception desk to let us know.

### Buses

The bus Route 6 goes to the main train station ("Hauptbahnhof"). The closest bus stop is in the street "Rappenberghalde", parallel to the campsite.

### Walking

You can get to the old town in about 15 or 20 minutes, where you can take stroll and discover the numerous places of interest in Tübingen, as well as go shopping or visit one of the charming restaurants of the town. At the reception you can get a map of the city.

### Public tour of the city

Take a city tour daily at 2:30 pm at the tourist-information (german). Saturdays in English at 11 am.

### Public punting trips

They take place every day at 1 pm (from April until October) at the boarding place "Hölderlinturm". Tickets are available at the tourist-information on the Neckar Bridge.
